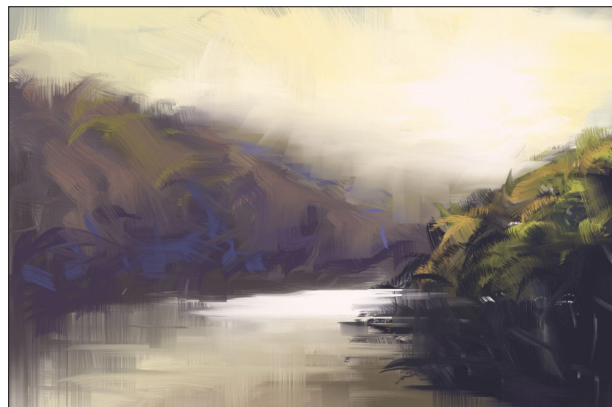

## WHERE IT STARTED

In 1833 William Wilberforce was finally able to convince the House of Commons and House of Lords to outlaw slavery across the British Empire. 800,000 slaves were subsequently released

Now in 2019, estimates range from **21(ILO) to 48(GSI) Million souls** enslaved within 167 countries including Australia. Much of the horror far too horrible to be able to share in mixed company.

## WHY NOW?

It is no coincidence that we are launching our **Paint4Freedom** Art Competition now.

In March 2018, the Hon. Paul Green MLC introduced a Modern Slavery Bill, the first of its kind in Australia. The Bill with amendments, the Modern Slavery Act 2018, finally passed the Parliament of NSW on Thursday June 21st to lead the nation in tackling the crimes of human trafficking and modern slavery. After debate in the Federal Parliament, the Modern Slavery Bill 2018 (Cth) passed both houses of Federal Parliament on November 29th, 2018 and was given Royal Assent on December 10th, 2018 as the final step to its enactment.

The Modern Slavery Bill now brings Australia into line with the UK (where modern slavery legislation came into force in 2015) and reflects growing awareness for the need to address modern slavery both domestically and internationally.

Since the legislation was implemented in the UK, very little has changed. We believe here in Australia, only us as the general public can make things change.

## WHAT IS THE PAINT4FREEDOM ART COMPETITION?

**Paint4Freedom** is a National Art Competition open to Amateur Artists including Budding (15-18yrs) Amateurs, Emerging and Established Artists. The aim of the competition is to help better educate the general public about Modern-day Slavery.

The Local Community Paint4Freedom Art Competitions are taking place during July 1st through to December 31st, 2019. The aim is that those artists and their works who are selected, may at the local

community competitions, will go on to compete in regional, state and finally the nation level of competition.

We are also focussed on encouraging as many of our Indigenous Australians to take part in the Paint4Freedom Art Competition according to their age and artist / career status in the Local Community Paint4Freedom Art Competition or the State and National Levels depending on their artistic standing.

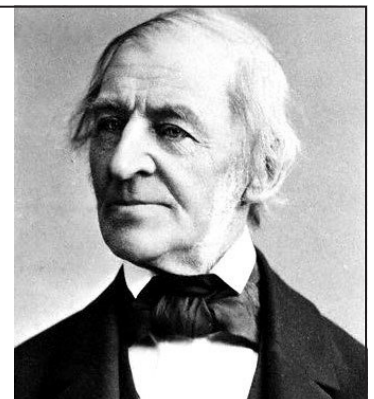
