### ***ABOUT MASONITE PANELS***

**\*\*If you are doing some or all of your 9x5 works on Masonite, and not on paper, then you will need to buy a set of four panels from the Julian Ashton Art School.**

The School (for the sake of our newer members) is located at Hut 17 Headland Park, Middle Head Rd Mosman (opposite Cobbittee St). Just turn of Middle Head Rd and bear left coming up to Frenchy's Café on the front right and the car park will be on the left.

***The School will be open on Saturday and Sunday 16 and 17 and 23 and 24 August from 12 noon to 3pm. Committee members will be present to help you.***

The price is \$10 for a set of 4 panels. You can buy more than one set if you wish.. They are machine cut exactly to the right dimensions so as to fit into the Julian Ashton Art School frames. You can use the smooth or the rough sides. A coat of Gesso gives you a good working surface. Any questions or query, just phone Elise Brooks on 99692634.

Exhibition invitations will be sent to you on 4 September for distribution to friends, family and fellow workers. Our members are our best advertisers and promoters.
