Artworks NOT selected must be collected between Tuesday 16th March and Thursday 18th March, 10am - 5pm

The Exhibition period will be from Saturday 20th March - Saturday 24th April 2021.

Paul and Sue Delprat were consulted regarding MAS holding an easter exhibition at JAAS, however, due to the confined space of JAAS premises it was decided that in the interest of general health no exhibition will be held until later in the year.

MOSMAN YOUTH ART PRIZE

The MAS Committee voted to cease sponsorship of the North Sydney Art Prize (which has been cancelled until 2022) but instead increase our sponsorship of the Mosman Youth Art Prize to \$500 which will also lead to maximum exposure of MAS.

ARTISTS SEMINAR AT MOSMAN ART GALLERY

Annie Woodham has conferred with **Wayne Tunncliffe** (Curator of Australian Art at AGNSW) to speak about **Arthur Streeton** and Sydney with a focus on the Harbour and the influence on Australian Art on Friday the 14th May .

Paul Delprat has most generously agreed to speak about the Artists camp at Curlew Camp. This Seminar coincides with the 130th Anniversary of Arthur Streeton coming to stay at Curlew Camp. More information regarding ticketing/number of attendees permitted etc will follow at a later date.
